BROE2 Files

BROE2 Exports all of the information in one Zip file. The Zip file contains 12 files which are used by competitions. Some of the files are similar to others but with a different number of rows.

Crews

This file contains crews in a competition regardless of their status

| Date Submitted | Sometimes used to determine if crews have to be rejected due to too many crews. The format of the first is DD/MM/YY HH:MM:SS |

| Event Identity | Internal code of the event |
| Event Override Name | Name displayed at all stages |
| Composite | Y or N – flag if the crew is a composite |
| CompositeCode | 3 letter codes of the clubs in the crew |
| Submitting Club | Name of the club submitting the entry. Club of the crew unless a composite |
| Submitting Club Index | 3 letter code of the club submitting the entry |
| Submitting Administrator Name | Normally Entry sec for the club |
| Submitting Administrator Email | Used to email the required information to the club |
| Competition Contact Name | Contact information for the crew on the day |
| Competition Contact Home Telephone | Contact information for the crew on the day |
| Competition Contact Mobile Telephone | Contact information for the crew on the day |
| Competition Contact Work Telephone | Contact information for the crew on the day |
| Competition Contact Email | Contact information for the crew on the day |
| PreEvent Contact Name | Contact information for the crew before day |
| PreEvent Contact Home Telephone | Contact information for the crew before day |
| PreEvent Contact Mobile Telephone | Contact information for the crew before day |
| PreEvent Contact Work Telephone | Contact information for the crew before day |
| PreEvent Contact Email | Contact information for the crew before day |
| Paid | Y or N – shows if the entry has been paid for |
| Payment Date | Sometimes used to determine if crews have to be rejected due to too many crews |
| Payment Type | Online, Manual, Unpaid – Often used by the treasurer to help reconcile payments. |
| Refunded | Y or N – shows if the crew has been refunded. |
| Current Crew Status | Submitted, Accepted, Rejected, Withdraw, Scratched – replaces the multiple flags of OEI |
| Notes | Large field for clubs to put notes against a crew |
| Boat Name | Anything that the club wants to call the boat |
| Boat ID | ID of the boat record in BROE |

| Boating Permissions Club Index Code | Only used on tideway – 3 letter code |
| Boating Permissions Club Email | Only used on tideway – from the club record |

| Band Name | Name of the band when an event is banded. |
| Group | Name of the group if a band is split into groups |
| CrewLetter | A-Z Letter assigned by a club to the crew |
| CompetitionNotes | Only available to the organisers |
| Rowing CRI | Calculated from the current competitors |
| Sculling CRI | Calculated from the current competitors |

Crew Baselines

This file has the same columns as the Competitors, except that the PRIs are as at the close of entries.

WithdrawnRejectedScratched Crews

This file contains the crews that have withdrawn, been rejected, or have scratched. It has most of the columns as the Crews. The columns missing are Band Name, Crew Letter, Competition Notes, CRI and Baseline CRIs and Status flags.

Starting List

This file contains crews in a competition regardless of their status

| Rowing CRI | Calculated from the current competitors |
| Rowing CRI Max | Calculated from the current competitors |
| Sculling CRI | Calculated from the current competitors |
| Coxing CRI | Calculated from the current competitors |
| Coxing CRI Max | Calculated from the current competitors |
| Baseline Rowing CRI | Baseline for the crews when calculating changes |
| Baseline Sculling CRI | Baseline for the crews when calculating changes |
| Baseline Coxing CRI | Baseline for the crews when calculating changes |
| Band | Name of the band when an event is banded. |
| Group | Name of the group if a band is split into groups |
| Verdict | The winning verdict is declared for a race if declared. Blank if not. |

Competitors

This file contains all the competitors in a competition. It does not include competitors in rejected, withdrawn, or scratched crews.

| Column | Notes |
|-------------------------|--|
| Crew ID | Links the competitor to the crew |
| Position | Position of the competitor in the boats (1 – 8 or Cox) |
| Membership Number | Needed when checking against membership card |
| Surname | For checking competitors and publishing crew compositions |
| First Names | For checking competitors and publishing crew compositions. <i>(It is recommended that only initials are used in published paperwork. Although first names are needed at certain positions.)</i> |
| Age | Calculated age of the competitor using the various age rules <i>Junior Events – Uses the Junior rule</i> <i>U19, U23 Events – Uses the U19, U23 rule</i> <i>Senior, Master Events – Uses the Masters rule</i> |
| Gender | M or F – used to see the mix of genders in a crew |
| Cox | Y if the competitor is the cox of the crew |
| Members Club Name | Full Name of the Club – used for composite crews |
| Members Club Index Code | 3 letter code for the club – used for composite crews |
| Rowing PRI | Competitor rowing PRI for the event |
| Sculling PRI | Competitor Sculling PRI for the event |
| Coxing CRI | Calculated from the current competitors |
| Substitute | Yes or No – used for working out how much of the crew has been substituted |
| Membership Type | Type of membership held, eg RACE – Adult, Race – Junior, ROW, etc. |

Custom Crew Information

This file contains any custom crew information. This can be uploaded back into BROE2 for displaying to the clubs in the same format.

| Custom Crew Number | Starting (or Back) Number of the crew |
| Custom Crew Name | Name of the crew as allocated by the competition |

Note: This is also available at *Setup* → *Custom crew information* for transfer the custom information into BROE2

Masters Handicaps

This file contains the actual age category of every Master's crew. A masters crew can enter a category of a younger age band.

| Submitting Club | As in the Crew Export |
| Submitting Club Index | As in the Crew Export |

Clubs

This file contains the contact details for the clubs in the competition. This includes all of the clubs in a composite crew.

| Club Abbreviation | Shorten name of the club |
| Club Code | 3 or 4 letter code for the club. Overseas clubs will have a 4 letter code starting with Z |
| Colours | Official colours of a club |
| Blades | Description of the blade |
| Bladelmage | Link to an image of the blade. |

Events

This file contains events in a competition.

| Column | Notes |

| Event ID | ID of the event |
| Event Identity | Basic code for an event eg Op.4x- |
| Number Of Rowers | Actual number of rowers or sculling seats in an event |
| Sculling Status | Y or N for sculling or rowing respectively |
| Coxed Status | Y or N if a boat has a cox |
| Event Gender | Open or Female |
| Event Type | Senior, Junior or Master |
| Age Restriction | For Masters - minimum age for a crew when all competitors ages are averaged according to the RoR For Juniors, U19, U23 - maximum age for an competitor in a crew |
| Sub Category | U19, U23, or A – K for masters |
| Event Info | Information for competitors to use |
| Notes | Large field for competitions to provide information for clubs |
| Fee | Fee for the event |
| Override Name | Name of the event that is displayed everywhere |
| Previous Event ID | The ID of the event from the previous running. Generated when a competition copies events from the previous year |
| Columns for each Division | 0 or 1. Column name is the name of the division. Show if a division is available for an event |
| Bands | A list of the Bands in an event separated by a pipe |

Event Bands

This file contains bands for events in a competition.

| EventName | Basic code for an event eg Op.4x- |
| BandName | Name of Band as displayed |
| NumberOfGroups | Number of horizontal groups |
| Group1ID | ID of the Band and the first group |
| Group2ID | ID of the second group (0 if no group) |
| Group3ID | ID of the third group (0 if no group) |

Note: This is also available at *Information* → *Event Bands* in the “Event Banding” section for transfer the band information into BROE2. When creating new bands for an event The IDs are left blank. If the same file is uploaded with no IDs, then more bands and group will be created.

Divisions

This file contains divisions that events can be allocated to.

Crew Bands

This file contains the banding and grouping information for crews. If modified it can be used to upload the banding information back into BROE2.

AllClubCodes

This file contains information all clubs in BROE2. *This is not in the zip file.*

Results upload for Heads or league based regattas

This is the format of the file for uploading results into BROE2. *Columns in italics are not required but are recommended to be in the files to help analyse the results file if there are problems.*

| <i>Event</i> | Name of the event |
| <i>Band</i> | Only needs to be present if events have been banded. This is the Band Name as defined on the Events Bands page. |

| <i>Division</i> | Only needs to be present if the competition has Divisions |
| <i>Crew Num</i> | If crews are given numbers then they can be recorded here |
| <i>Crew Letter</i> | The assigned crew letter for the crew if applicable |
| <i>Crew Name</i> | Crew name from the competition or BROE2 |
| <i>Submitting Club Index</i> | Submitting Club ID from BROE2 |
| <i>Submitting Club</i> | Submitting Club from BROE2 |
| <i>Position In Event</i> | Position in the event AFTER masters handicaps have been taken off or time penalties applied. |
| <i>Raw Time</i> | The time taken without any handicaps or time penalties being applied. This is the time used for calculating the RP |
| <i>Time</i> | The time taken with all handicaps and time penalties applied. This is the time use for checking the Position in Event and I the almanack |
| <i>Status</i> | This is one of the following: Did Not Start; Did Not Finish; Time Only; Finished; Disqualified |
| <i>Verdict</i> | If a verdict is given, then it can be recorded here. Normally blank for Heads. |

Results upload for Races

This is the format of the file for uploading results into BROE2. *Columns in italics are not required but are recommended to be in the files to help analyse the results file if there are problems.*

| EventDay | Only needed if the events are raced over several days |
| Time | Time of the race in HH:MM or HH:MM:SS format |
| RaceNumber | This must increase through the rounds of an event and be unique for all races. |
| <i>EventName</i> | |
| Band | Only needs to be present if events have been banded. This is the Band Name as defined on the Events Bands page. |
| Group | Only needs to be present if events have been banded and grouped. This is the Group Name (Group 1, Group 2, etc) as shown on the Events Bands page. |
| Event ID | Required |
| Round | The round of the event. It must be one of the following: Eliminator, Head, QuarterFinal, SemiFinal, Final. A number or letter can be added after a space to the Round, eg Heat 1 |
| <i>NextRace</i> | If supplied, then the upload system will use this for validation |
| <i>L?-CrewNum</i> | For each lane in the event there needs to be a L? set of information. ie L1-, L2-, L3-, L4-, L5-, L6- for a six lane course. |
| <i>L?-CrewName</i> | |
| <i>L?-CrewID</i> | Required BROE Crew ID |
| <i>L?-Posn</i> | Position of the crew in the race, 0 if disqualified, DNF etc |
| <i>L?-Time</i> | Used for the almanack if present |
| <i>L?-Status</i> | One of the following: DNS, DNF, DSQ, SCR, NRO, FIN, WIN |
| <i>Winner-CrewNum</i> | Used to valid to validate the lane information |

| Verdict | Used for the almanack if distances are used rather than times |

Version History

Version 8 - June 20 - Removal of unused information

The “MAX” versions of the CRI and PRI are removed. Entry and Club secretary information removed as these are not maintained in BROE2.

Version 7 - September 19 - New Export - All club codes

All clubs available in BROE2 can be exported with a URL for the blades.

Version 6 - September 19 - Changes in Competitors CSV file

The Membership Number is now only a number, no expiry or membership type. A new “Membership Type” column added.

Version 5 - April 19 - Removal of Status Points

All references to Status Points have been removed in competitor, crew, starting list exports.

Version 5 - April 19 - Date Submitted and Payment Date have the time as well as date

Date Submitted and Payment Date have the Date and Time rather than just date.

Version 5 - April 19 - Starting List columns updated

Starting List column names have been updated to match the results upload file for heads.

Version 5 - April 19 - Removal of Entry and Club Secretaries

References to Entry Secretary and Club Secretary have been removed in Crew and Club files.

Version 5 - April 19 - Removal of Status Points and more information about Date Submitted

All references to Status Points have been removed in competitor, crew, starting list exports, . Date Submitted and Payment Date have the Date and Time rather than just date. Starting List column names have been updated to match the results upload file for heads. References to Entry Secretary and Club Secretary have been removed in Crew and Club files.

Version 4 - May 18 - Added Competition File

A new file “competition.csv” has been added with the competition status

Version 3 - May 18 - Results upload for Races

The name of the CrewID columns have been standardised.

The explanation of the group column has been revised. The Verdict column has been made mandatory.
